


PRAYER REQUESTS/ HEALING/ GOD'S WILL

HOW TO PLAY

Guess the **WORDLE** in 6 tries.

Each guess must be a valid 5 letter word. Hit the enter button to submit.

After each guess, the color of the tiles will change to show how close your guess was to the word.

Examples



The letter **W** is in the word and in the correct spot.




The letter **I** is in the word but in the wrong spot.



The letter **U** is not in the word in any spot.

A new **WORDLE** will be available each day!

Players only get one five letter word per 24 hours. The game keeps the player's stats of how many tries it takes to guess 'the word of the day'.



Culberson Family Stats:

Read this before you play:

1. Familiarize yourself with the instructions. See above.
2. **Choose your first word carefully.**
Hint: Start with a five letter word that has two or more vowels OR commonly used consonants.
3. The same letter may be in the word more than once.
Ex: robot
4. Think of the game Wheel of Fortune. Instead of a phrase etc., though- it's a five letter word.
