

Scholarships for post high school graduates:

1. The Rev. Thurmond Coleman Sr. and Deacon Frank Weaver Scholarships are available to any active FBCJ sophomore through senior students pursuing their undergraduate degree. This is a one time award, if you have received this scholarship in the past you will not be eligible to apply. Any FBCJ student who wishes to apply please contact the Scholarship Ministry at scholarships@fbcjtown.org, applications are due by May 14, 2023.

2.The Denise G. Overstreet Scholarship is to honor an adult learner at First Baptist Church who wants to attend college and earn or complete a degree. Applicants can be a Male or Female adult learner age 21 or older who is seeking an Associates, Bachelors, or higher degree, participation in at least one church ministry and demonstrate need by writing an essay in addition to filling out the application. 3.
